Getting Here

The airport is located within the city, and is about a 30 minute bus ride from the hotel in downtown Winnipeg. Taxis are also available as well as TappCar.

The Delta Hotel (350 St Mary Avenue) is widely accessible by public transportation/ buses, and these all have the ability to lower ramps. During rush hour, buses can get quite full and may be standing room only.

Washrooms

- Hotel Concierge (First Floor):
 - Washrooms are available on the first floor of the Delta Hotel.
 - A wheelchair accessible family washroom, with a change table, is also available in this area.
- Main Conference Level (Second Floor):
 - Washrooms, with wheelchair accessible stalls, are available on the Main Conference Level.
 - A gender inclusive washroom will be available on the Main Conference Level, in the Transcona Room. This washroom will only be available when Conference Planning Committee Members are present in the Transcona Room, as the room will be used as a temporary office for the Conference Planning Committee for the duration of the conference, and will be locked when empty.
- Concourse Level (Lower Level):
 - Washrooms, with wheelchair accessible stalls, on the concourse level are available.
 - A gender inclusive will also be available for the duration of the conference.

Please Note: The available washrooms at the Delta Hotel do not have automatic entrance doors.

The parkade at the Delta Hotel has elevator access though please be aware that you will encounter non-automatic heavy doors on each level.
